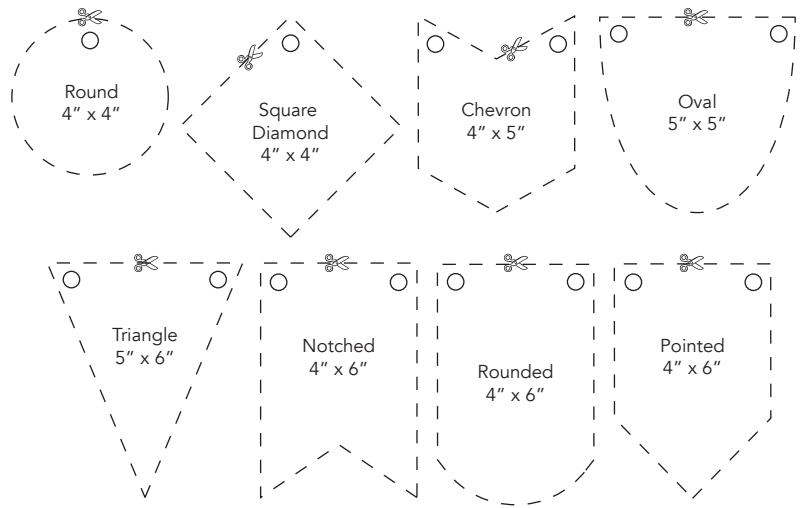


# HOW-TO GUIDE Suggested Instructions for Your Party Decorations

**BANNERS** Used to decorate a dessert table, entrance or wall  
**Suggested Paper Stock:** Heavy-weight card stock. Glossy stock typically gives the best print outcome.  
**Supplies Needed:** scissors or knife and ruler, hole punch, string or ribbon

- 1) Print as many as you may need. (If adding words, ensure you have enough for each letter of the saying)
- 2) Cut out shape following dotted lines.
- 3) Punch hole in suggested location on the banner. Hole diametres may vary depending on hole punch. Choose size that will fit the ribbon or string you choose. it is best to punch the hole at least 1/4" away from the edge to prevent from ripping.
- 4) Banner fillers can be used to separate words or at each end of the banner for extra decoration.
- 5) Run string or ribbon through the holes and cut string at desired length.
- 6) Be sure to leave enough excess string or ribbon at both ends to hang.

**Suggested Paper Stock:** Regular text weight paper or light-weight card stock is sufficient.  
**Supplies Needed:** scissors or knife and ruler, double-sided tape or glue

- 1) Print the saying you want.
- 2) Cut out letters following dotted lines.
- 3) Tape or glue letter on top of banner.
